STATE OF WISCONSIN | TOWN OF MAPLE | DOUGLAS COUNTY Ordinance No. 2024-1 | Ordinance Adopting Notice of Public Records Access

The Town Board of the Town of Maple, Douglas County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 19.34, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, adopts a Notice of Records Access, which, pursuant to s. 19.34 (1), Wis. stats., contains a description of the town's organization and the established times and places at which, the legal custodian from whom, and the methods whereby the public may obtain information from and access to records in the town's custody, make requests for town records, or obtain copies of town records, and the costs thereof, and the requisite Notice of Public Record Access to this ordinance is so adopted.

The town clerk shall prominently display and make available for inspection and copying at the town offices copies of the Notice of Records Access, for the public's guidance.

This ordinance is effective on February 8th, 2024. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
