COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. County Supervisor

The County Supervisor reviewed highway repairs and zoning committee changes. There was a discussion of tax bills. There was discussion with the Mayor of Superior regarding emergency services and times when the bridge will be closed. The property up for bid on Highway 13 had 8 bids and must be cleaned up by July 1st, 2026, due to the snow and cold.

The Town Foreman states there was mechanical issues with plowing. They may need to buy blades for the new plow from Douglas County.

3. Fire Department

The VFD responded to 4 emergency calls this past month. All trucks are in good working order.
